

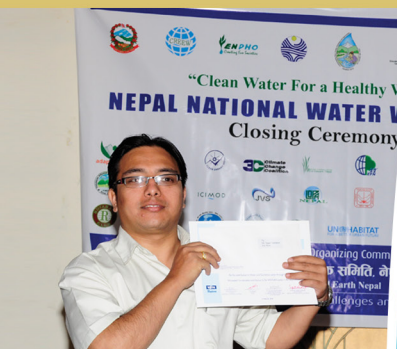

WASH Media Fellowship Award 2011



Department of Water Supply and Sewerage, Government of Nepal and UN HABITAT Water for Asian Cities Programme Nepal in coordinated of GUTHI is going to organize the WASH Media Fellowship Award 2011.

The fellowship aims to encourage and bring together the WASH journalists to initiate research based media reporting, which in turn contribute in dissemination of effective and correct information among the public and policy makers as well. These initiatives could be effective and efficient to bring local initiatives in a wider spectrum and to help in strengthening the efforts in the sector. Apart from it, the fellowship also aims to build and foster sustainable relation of the sector players with media in the country.

Adequate and safe drinking water and sanitation is essential for the healthy life. In Nepal, more efforts are needed to achieve Millennium Development Goal as well as National Goal to access basic drinking water and sanitation service to all. Media can contribute the WASH sector by creating awareness through its vast network and reach in different form. The journalists are making remarkable contribution in wider dissemination of WASH issues and achievements in Nepal. Since last few years, WASH issues has become a regular part of the Nepalese media.

The WASH Media Fellowship Award 2011 is a flexible opportunity for the print, radio and television journalists to pursue an area of interest in WASH issues and policy.

The journalist are requested to submit the proposals for the fellowship along with at least 3 previous published /broadcasted/telecasted works related to WASH not later than 3 PM 25 November 2011.

The journalists will be awarded fellowship on evaluation of their previous works by a panel of jury with experts on WASH and journalism.

The fellowship winners have to produce at least 1 story on WASH issues and disseminate it through their associated media within a month from the date of the awarded.
